GUEST SPEAKERS:

Justice Brent Appel was appointed to the Supreme Court in 2006. Prior to his appointment he was engaged in private practice from 1987 until 2006 and was Iowa Deputy Attorney General from 1983 until 1987.

Betsy Clarke is the founder and President of the Juvenile Justice Initiative. She served as Juvenile Justice Counsel for the Cook County Public Defender for six years, and served for 15 years at the State Appellate Defender.

Alicia D'Addario is a Senior Attorney with the Equal Justice Initiative where she has worked extensively on EJI's campaign against sentencing young children to die in prison and other efforts to assist indigent defendants and prisoners who have been denied fair and just treatment in the legal system.

Billy Edwards is a deputy public defender in Los Angeles County and is considered one of the early pioneers in the training of attorneys around issues involving fetal alcohol syndrome.

Brian Farrell is a Lecturer at the University of Iowa College of Law and Assistant director of its Center for Human Rights. Brian is a co-founder of the Innocence Project of Iowa and teaches a course on wrongful convictions.

Rory J McMahon is former federal probation officer and has operated his own successful investigative agency for the past 25 years. He is the Chair of the Investigative Classes at S2institute.com

Judge William Owens currently serves as co-chair of the Iowa Supreme Court's Advisory Committee for Children's Justice; is a member of the State Council of the Iowa Supreme Court Commission for Children's Justice; and is chair of the Juvenile Judge Committee of the Iowa Judge's Association.

Brent Pattison is an Associate Clinical Professor of Law at Drake University and the Director of the Middleton Center for Children's Rights.

George Schiro is the DNA Technical Leader and Forensic Scientist at Scales Biological Laboratory in Brandon, Mississippi. He has over 30 years of forensic science and crime scene investigation experience.

Joe Slemko is a police officer with 29 years of service. He has acted as a private forensics consultant in the area of bloodstain pattern analysis and crime scene reconstruction for 17 years.

Dr. Josh Woods is Assistant professor of psychology and director of the Cognition and Memory Research Lab at Grand View University.
